

INSTRUCTIONS FOR MAKING SPOT MATCHING GAME

1. Print both of the spotty pages below.
2. Laminate both copies if you can to help keep the game clean and hard wearing. If you don't have access to a laminator skip this step and maybe keep the game in a plastic filing pocket.
3. Cut up the first spotty page along the red lines, leaving you with 8 rectangular shapes. I have rounded the corners so that they aren't sharp. This is particularly important if you have laminated the sheets.
4. I have made the boundaries of the 8 pieces quite defined but if they still don't stand out you might find it helpful to use a marker pen to make them stronger.
5. You are now ready to play! The aim is to cover every spot on the complete sheet with the 8 pieces you have cut out. They fit perfectly, there shouldn't be any spaces!
